# Lent - welcome to the journey of knowing!

'Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known'. (1 Corinthians 13:12 NIV)

We don't yet see things clearly. We're squinting in a fog, peering through a mist. But it won't be long before the weather clears and the sun shines bright! We'll see it all then, see it all as clearly as God sees us, knowing Him directly just as He knows us!'

(1 Corinthians 13:12 - The Message)

Knowledge can be a wonderful thing can't it! When we don't understand something, it can be unsettling, or frustrating. We feel ignorant or vulnerable and defenceless – about whatever it is we don't know.

But to know something is to be enlightened! Knowledge gives confidence, re-assurance, a comfort from being able to understand and see.

There are many things we do not know or understand about our world, or why things are why they are. But perhaps the two things we long to understand most come down to knowing' 'ourselves' and 'God'.

'Who am I'? 'What am I doing here'? 'Does my life have any meaning or value'? These are some of the big questions we ask of ourselves and long to know. And then there's God. 'Who is God'? 'How can I know or understand this God'? 'What is God's relationship with me, or mine with God'?

We can spend our whole lives exploring these questions. We might even look to the Church for some answers.

After 61 years asking these questions, I would say that exploring one helps us understand more about the other. Knowing more of God leads me to knowing more about myself – and knowing more about me points me to a deeper awakening of God. As Teresa of Avila, the 16<sup>th</sup> century Carmelite nun, once said: 'We find God in ourselves, and we find ourselves in God'.

This, my friends, is the exploration we are invited to embark on in Lent!

This week we begin 40 days following Jesus from his baptism, through his ministry, and to his cross and resurrection. We journey with him, and as we

travel, we learn more about why God came as Jesus, and lived and died and rose again to restore *us* to union with God - and how it was all driven by God's love for *us*.

And in Lent we are also encouraged to look inward at ourselves. And as we do, we discover our own worth: that we have immense value; that we are loved; that *despite our unknowing, we are fully known by God* - and our lives make sense only in union with him.



As 'The Message' version of 1 Corinthians 13 I've quoted says: We only see now like squinting in fog. But we keep looking until the cloud clears, and the sun shines, and we know that God knows us, and that God's got us, and maybe that's all we ever need to know!

So welcome to Lent! Enjoy the exploration!



The CAP money course is a money management course that teaches budgeting skills that can help you to make the most of your money, and to worry less about money. The course has a proven track record; it has been running for over 25 years though the material has recently been updated.

The content is relevant to most people who want to be more in control of their finances. The material is very accessible and easy to follow. The course can either be run over 4 sessions of about 2 hours or a shortened course can be run in a day.

or consider that the amount of tax you have paid in the current year is less than will be reclaimed on your total donations (currently £25.00 can be reclaimed for every £100 donated).


