### **Celebrating the Holy Spirit**

This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday when we celebrate the work and ministry of God the Holy Spirit. But why celebrate? We know the Holy Spirit is God, but where is it? And how do we access this Spirit?

Some Christians talk about being 'baptised' in the Holy Spirit, or anointed by the Spirit in a conversion type experience - which is great if that has happened to you – but what about the rest of us? How do we get to experience this Spirit of God?

Let me talk about 'Shekinah'! *Shekinah* is a Hebrew word that Jews use to describe the indwelling presence of God.

The first time we read about the presence of God coming and residing with God's people was in the tabernacle that Moses built in the wilderness. The tabernacle was where God was said to live, and it meant the people knew that God was travelling with them. Exodus 40 tells us that 'the glory of the Lord came and filled the Tabernacle'.

Then, hundreds of years later, the presence of God moved to the temple. 2 Chron 7 says: 'When Solomon finished praying..., the glorious presence of the Lord filled the Temple. The priests could not enter the Temple of the Lord because the glorious presence of the Lord filled it'.

But so what? Well, the Holy Spirit is, I believe, the very shekinah indwelling presence of God. It proves God is present!

And where is God's Spirit now? Well, that's the exciting bit! In Acts 2 we read that the Holy Spirit came down and rested on the disciples. In past times, God dwelt with his people in the tabernacle or temple. But at Pentecost, God's Spirit came down on the disciples. They had become the new temple – where God resided.

And we too, are temples for God the Holy Spirit to make her dwelling.1 Cor 3 says: 'All of you together are the temple of God and the Spirit of God lives in you'.

And Romans 8 says: 'Even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you life.... The Spirit of God...lives in you.... and gives life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you'. Don't you find that amazing? *You* are the dwelling-place of God the Holy Spirit. Yes - even you; Even me!

So rejoice! We all already have the Holy Spirit. God has proved their love for you by the Holy Spirit making her home in you without you having to do anything!

You have the shekinah presence of God abiding in you! Right now! This instant!

And that's something well worth celebrating!

The course teaches budgeting skills that can help you make the most of your money, and to worry less about money. The content is relevant to most people who want to be more in control of their finances. The material is very accessible



### Farewell and Thank you to Jon Cook!

This weekend we say farewell to Jon Cook – our CAP Eden Debt Centre Manager, who is stepping down after leading our Debt Centre for the last 8 ½ years!

Jon joined us to head up our brand-new CAP Debt Centre in October 2015, and the Centre officially opened in December of that year.

In that time, the Centre has managed over £1.4 million worth of debt, with over £1 million of debt cleared!



We have worked with 175 different households, and been able to help 126 different families, with 70 going debt-free, and 40 others reaching additional positive outcomes. 14 families are currently actively working with us.

We have partnered and worked alongside local councils, GP's, health & social workers, schools, Mental health practitioners, the DWP, multiple community support groups, housing associations, food banks, churches, the Police, Politicians and counsellors, neighbours, families, friends and work colleagues.

Facebook, radio, newspaper and TV have all helped us carry the message of hope and light to people who most need it.

Every home we have entered we have carried the presence of God and displayed the kingdom of God, serving people in love.

We have mobilised the church across Eden to engage in mission in their local community. Around 35 people have served as befrienders over the years with nearly 20 currently active. We have a passionate and dedicated Management team and so many others praying for our work and helping in many different ways.

We have raised in the region of £200k over the last 8 years to help run our CAP services. And upwards of £30k has been provided through grants from other organisations to people in crisis as blessings and emergency aid.

In addition to the Debt Centre, we now run an effective CAP Job Club and are about to launch a new, re-modelled CAP Money programme – building on the success of previous CAP Money Courses. Jen Dixon, who was our other Debt Coach will now be our Debt Centre Manager and is an amazing person to follow Jon in heading our ministry. And we are delighted that Jo Varley – who was previously a CAP Debt coach in Kendal – will be joining us as our second Debt coach!

God is good! And God continues to shower his blessings on our work.

But I do want you to join me in saying a massive thank-you to Jon, who has led us so magnificently these last 8 ½ years.

Jon has been an inspirational leader. His passion, his heart for God, and his love for people has been key to what God has been doing in and through us.

Jon is leaving to pursue where God is calling him in his work with Kings Church, and we wish him, his wife Karen, and his family every blessing in what lies ahead.

Jon – thank you for everything, and we look forward to what God has in store for all of us!
