# **Election Special**



Don't worry, I'll try not to be contentious.

But if you look across the pond you'll see just how divisive politics can be and how swathes of churches/church-goers align (entrench?) themselves to a political party and deeply mistrust anyone with other allegiances. I'm glad it isn't anywhere near as bad as that here for most of us, at least not yet.

I'm currently reading a book co-authored by Tom Wright and Michael Bird - 'Jesus and the Powers' -which speaks to the subject of Christians and politics, historically and contemporary, and I share a few bits of their wisdom here. God's intention was and still is for human government and authority for the benefit of his world and within his providence. Jesus himself acknowledged that Pontius Pilate, a pagan governor, had a God-given authority over him! (John 19:11)

But the challenge for each is generation of Christians is, how do we build for God's Kingdom in the context of menacing empires and flawed political systems? We do well to remember that God 'disposes kings and sets up kings' (Dan 2:21) and 'dominion belongs to the LORD; he rules over the nations' (Ps 22:28) and that is borne out in Scripture from Pharaoh to Assyrians, Babylonians and Romans. Kings and empires may 'rage' and 'conspire' against God and his anointed king, but they are doomed to failure.

The Creator's design for good human government finds its ultimate fulfilment in this: God has appointed Jesus as the King of kings and Lord of lords. That's our message and the church's vocation is to build for His Kingdom – a kingdom that is not of this world, but it certainly is for this world. Which means we shouldn't avoid politics but rather use it as we are able to make a positive difference to human flourishing.

Human rulers only have a delegated authority and they should be obedient and will be held to account. So as well as casting your vote, answer the call to pray for those in authority (1 Tim 2:2).










The next Woodland Collective meeting is Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June.



These will be taken to an orphanage and refugee centre in UKRAINE where they will be made into TRENCH CANDLES, which are used for light, heat and even cooking.




The soldiers also need (in good condition) socks, woolly hats and gloves. AND (NEW) toothbrushes, toothpaste and razors.









We are also collecting anything related to children for the orphanage and refugee centre.


They need toys and clothes in good condition.
