#### **Pets**



Apart from the first few months of our married life, this is the first time we have not had a pet to share our home. As a child I did not have any pets (not even a goldfish) so when our first pet, a cat named Tiger, decided to adopt us I discovered how animals can enrich our lives. Over the years we have had 4 cats and 5 dogs (never more than one at once) and each has been valued and loved.

All the animals have been rescued and the most recent dog, Fluffy, was extra special. He was rescued from Romania where he had a miserable life. No one knew how old he was but he was blind in one eye, had only three teeth and was going deaf, yet he had a zest for life. Sadly he became very ill and we lost him just before Easter. He (and all the others) will never be forgotten.



This is not a sob story but a reflection on what our pets can teach us.

- They depend on us and we also depend on them. We give them a home, shelter and food and they give us their loyalty and love. The same can be said of our relationship with God. He provides for our needs and we are so privileged to have a home and all that we need in our daily lives. More than this his Saving Power and Guiding Hand reach out and embrace us. In turn he asks for our loyalty and trust in him and in response to his love, we love him in return.
- Pets also bring 'energy' to life. Some are more laid back than others but most show enthusiasm for their food, their walks and the affection given to them. Our Christian life also needs 'energy', a vitality and verve to show why our faith is exciting and special and how it is available to others. This is where the Holy Spirit comes in. We need to rely on him to guide and inspire us so that we can demonstrate the joy of our relationship with God.

Whether you are a pet lover or not, I hope you experience the unconditional love of God who accepts each one of us just as we are.






## 2.30PM START DOORS OPEN 2PM

We collect small coins for All We Can (the Methodist Relief and Development fund). It is amazing how these small collections mount up during the year.



These will be taken to an orphanage and refugee centre in UKRAINE where they will be made into TRENCH CANDLES, which are used for light, heat and even cooking.




The soldiers also need (in good condition) socks, woolly hats and gloves. AND (NEW) toothbrushes, toothpaste and razors.




