Experiencing God in the Mundane



"Don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself" (Matt. 6:34). This has always been quite a reassuring verse to me but some days I find myself thinking 'thanks Jesus but that's easier said than done!' In the stage of life I'm at right now I find it hard not to think about the future. Something that often involves a certain amount of worry.

Throughout my recent studies I've been challenged by the Celtic

mystics who saw every task they undertook as a way to encounter God. Whatever it was they came across, they saw it as an opportunity to pray. De Waal speaks about how those who chose to engage in this ancient spirituality took the ordinary, day-to-day tasks that lay before them and treated them sacramentally. In doing so they indicated a greater reality that lay before them and sought God in the mundane. Their pattern of prayer invited the sacred into even the most ordinary parts of their lives.

This is a spirituality that encourages us to look for and connect with God in all aspects of our lives, recognising the divine presence in all. I wonder if this could help us to develop a greater awareness of God's presence in our lives. Could it help me to be more present rather than focusing too much on that which is out of my control?

Rather than trudging through the day-to-day, becoming more and more burdened with thoughts of the future, could we seek to experience God in everything we do in the present? Our pattern of prayer could reflect an intention to see God moving in our lives and the lives of others. In turn, this could give us a more optimistic and hopeful mindset in a world where hope and optimism are hard to come by. Proverbs 3:6 says, "Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."

My invitation is to explore how this pattern of prayer might revitalise our faith and relationship with God. Can recognising God in the little things bring about transformation in your life?








Alpha - a place to explore the Christian faith in an open-minded environment. Everyone's welcome, you're invited no matter your background or beliefs.
