What if?



It's a simple question and can be asked in a variety of contexts and is the basis of many human endeavours, not least scientific, philosophical, and engineering pursuits.

But here, I want to draw your attention to its application when it's personal and we face uncertainty. Most - probably all - of us will have some experience of wrestling with the question and

how inevitably that somehow leads us to explore and then dwell on least favourable outcomes, even if our disposition leans sunny-side up. Perhaps you recognise that for yourself.

I love the film 'A Beautiful Mind' (based on a book of the same name) about the brilliant mathematician John Nash who was eventually awarded a Nobel Memorial Prize in Economic Sciences. Unfortunately (and the premise of the film), John had a life-long debilitating struggle with mental illness. In the closing scene he was asked how, after so many years stricken he managed to regain his composure, to which he replies:

'Like a diet of the mind, I just choose not to indulge certain appetites'.

It's a discipline not to allow the 'what ifs?' to prise an opening into the soul and let fears and anxiety flood in to steal away peace and joy. Trust is a conscious choice we have to repeatedly make to let go of our instincts and let our spirits submit to our loving Father's care and will.



If there's a 'what if?' currently harassing you, then like our family this week, seek and receive the comfort that comes from the love and prayers of family, friends and church – I firmly believe it's God's design that we do so.

I think it was Morgan who said (or quoted) recently this wonderful thought: God is already present in the future you fear. We may never be able to fully subscribe to the lyric 'all fear is gone' but fear can be put in its place and we 'can face tomorrow' - because He lives!

Tickets are £20 in advance or at the door (£5 for students)






Children and parents enjoyed a bring and share lunch with the birthday cake being kindly provided by Mrs Katherine Williamson. After lunch the children played a number of party games.
