# The Last Supper

Most teenagers have posters of footballers or pop stars decorating their bedroom walls. Me? I had a reproduction of this painting by Salvador Dali. What my parents did with it when I moved away, I don't know.

In 1949, Dali rediscovered his Roman Catholic faith and over the next few years painted a series of artworks with Christian themes including another of my

favourites, "Christ of St John of the Cross". Here, in "The Sacrament of the Last Supper", Dali depicts the night before the crucifixion as Jesus shares Bread and Wine with his friends. The upper room, though, in a typically Surrealist way, has become a 12-sided dodecahedron, with windows open to the wider world.

Jesus sits at the head of the table, surrounded by the 12 disciples. He points upwards. Perhaps this is the moment where he says that he is going back to his Father. Jesus already seems to be fading away somehow, becoming less tangible. We see the world almost through him. He breaks out of the room and enters his world, to be with us wherever we are – present with us, here and now.

Or, instead, perhaps he is pointing up towards those arms outstretched and the torso above him, while still speaking of the broken bread upon the table, "This is my body broken for you..."

The significance of the broken bread and poured out wine are far, far greater than being confined to a room in Jerusalem 2000 years ago. Jesus' death and his resurrection, then, are for everyone, everywhere and everywhen. The windows look out over Port Lligat where Dali lived, rather than Jerusalem, but they could be looking out over Penrith or wherever we live today. And the disciples are dressed in plain white robes rather than the clothes of 1st century Palestinians.

We cannot see their faces, so they could be me or you. Jesus says of the wine that it is his blood "shed for you and for many." And, perhaps the white robes also remind us of the robes that are worn at the Wedding Feast of the Lamb in the book of Revelation. Communion is "A foretaste of the heavenly banquet prepared for all people..." as it says in the final prayer of our communion service.

That's why I've always loved this painting. It reminds me of Christ's universal love for all people, in all places and at all times – including me, here, today! "His blood availed for *me*..." as Charles Wesley puts it. It reminds me, too, of his presence with me, here and now. As John Betjeman put it: nothing "can with this simple truth compare – That God was Man in Palestine And lives today in Bread and Wine." And, it reminds me of the place set for me at the banqueting table in my heavenly home.

Perhaps I need to go and buy another poster for my bedroom wall.


